MRS. MATILDA BRAYBROOK

Dolgeville—Mrs. Matilda Braybrook, widow of George H. Braybrook, died at 3:15 yesterday afternoon at her home in South Main street after an illness of three months which was caused by a complication of diseases.

She was born in Lotville [Fulton County], five miles northeast of here, Oct. 13, 1867, a daughter of the late Jerome Bliss and Mrs. Emogene Bliss. She was descended from Levi Bliss, who was a soldier in the Revolutionary War.

Since a young woman she has resided in this village. On January 1, 1889 she was married to [Mr. George H. Braybrook]. She was a member of the D.A.R, the Universalist Church, the Rebekah Lodge and the W.C.T.U.

She is survived by a daughter, Mrs. Grover [Emma] Luther, of this place; her mother, Mrs. Emogene Bliss, also of this village; and a sister, Mrs. Edward Youker, of St. Johnsville.

The funeral will be held from the home at 2 Wednesday afternoon, the Rev. C. A. Moulton of the Universalist church officiating, and interment will be in the local cemetery.
