WILLIAM BRAYDON, [SIC] ILL THREE MONTHS, DIES IN HOSPITAL

DOLGEVILLE—William J. Braybrook, Jr., 84, Middleville, died Monday in a Utica hospital. He had been ill for the last three months.

Mr. Braybrook was born Aug. 6, 1861 in Fairfield. His youth was spent in Fairfield and he later became a cheesemaker working at his trade in neighboring communities. He had resided in Middleville for the last thirty-six years.

Surviving are a sister-in-law, Mrs. Charles Braybrook, Middleville; a niece, Mrs. Grover [Emma] Luther, Dolgeville; two nephews, Elmer C. Braybrook, Gloversville, and Robert J. Braybrook, Ilion.

Funeral services were held at 3:15 yesterday in the Moore funeral home in this village. The Rev. C. [Clinton] A. Moulton of the Universalist church officiated. Burial was in Dolgeville cemetery.
