MARY ANN BRIDGE

The funeral of Mrs. Mary Ann Bridge was held in Canton Sunday. A Syracuse correspondent has the following:

"Mrs. Mary Ann Bridge, of Canton, died yesterday afternoon at 3 o'clock at the residence of her granddaughter, Mrs. E. G. Wells, No. 354 Delaware street. She was 81 years old and is survived by one daughter, Mrs. C. M. Eddy of Canton; a granddaughter, Mrs. Wells; four grandchildren: Cedric Palmer, Sidney Eddy, Ernest Jerome, and Richard Newman Wells, all of this city; also a sister, Mrs. Ellen P. Coe, of Canton.

"Mrs. Bridge had been confined to the house for thirteen years, suffering from a fractured hip. She had lived with her daughter at Canton, but for the past year had been visiting her granddaughter, Mrs. Wells. For the past week she had been suffering from heart trouble, which caused her death. For many years Mrs. Bridge took an active interest in church work at Canton, being a member of the Universalist church."
