Death of Curtis Brigham

Following an illness of three years, Curtis Brigham, 26, died last evening at the home of his aunt, Mrs. Eliza W. Hike, No. 35 Market Street. Mr. Brigham, in hopes of gaining back his strength, left Auburn three years ago for Richmond, Va., where he resided with his mother, Mrs. S. J. Greene. Several weeks ago he returned to this city, the trip South having failed to benefit him to any extent.

Mr. Brigham was well known in this city, as he attended the High School for about three years. After leaving High School he studied music in Syracuse University, and became very proficient in that art. He will be best remembered by Auburnians as an excellent pianist, having taken part in many entertainments and musicals in the city.

Besides his mother and aunt, Mrs. Hike, he leaves another aunt, Mrs. Ira Phelps.

The funeral will be held at the house Monday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Rev. H. M. Cary, the pastor of the First Universalist Church, will officiate. Burial will be made in Fort Hill.
