LOUIS BRIGHAM

PERRY, April 14—Louis J. Brigham, life-long Perry resident and former bookkeeper in the office of the Wyoming County Community Hospital, Warsaw, died in that hospital last night (April 13, 1956). He was 70. In ill health for a few years, Mr. Brigham fell in his home yesterday suffering a hip fracture. Death occurred shortly after admittance to the hospital.

The funeral service will be held at 2 p.m. Monday in the Eaton Funeral Home with burial in Hope Cemetery. The Rev. Phillip Mayer of the Universalist Church, of which Mr. Brigham was a member[, ] will officiate.

Born in Perry, Oct. 4, 1885, Mr. Brigham was the son of Henry and Abbie Clark Brigham. The family's farm home was within the village of Perry, and here Mr. Brigham lived all his lie. Until taken ill a few years ago he had been employed 10 years in the hospital.

The only survivor is his wife, the former Maude Hendee whom he wed in 1914.
