Dolgeville, July 23.—Following an illness caused by heart disease and complications, Franz Brill, 84, died at 4 o'clock yesterday afternoon at the home of his son, Bruno, on North Main street.

He was employed in the earlier days following his arrival here at the former Brambach piano factory and later worked for other local industries.
