Frank Brinaman

Frank Brinaman, 73, died at his home in Syracuse on Wednesday November 24th. Funeral services were held at his Syracuse home on Saturday and on Sunday at the home of his sister, Mrs. Seward [Jennie] Walrath, in Fort Plain.

Rev. William A. Haney, pastor of the Fort Plain Universalist Church, officiated. Mr. Brinaman was born in Fort Plain, January 8, 1869, the son of Jacob and Isabelle Bade Brinaman. His early life was spent in Fort Plain where he followed the trade of baking. For the past 50 years he had been a resident of Syracuse. He is survived by his wife, one son, Bert Brinaman, and one daughter, Miss Irene Brinaman, all of Syracuse; two sisters, Mrs. Jennie Walrath and Miss Alvira Brinaman, of St. Johnsville; several nieces and nephews.
