His Death Occurred This Morning After Long Illness.

Fort Plain, Dec. 31.—Jacob Brinamen died at his home on Main street this morning after an illness of several months. The deceased had been a resident of the village nearly his whole life time. He received his education here and followed the occupation of engineer until poor health compelled him to give up his duties. He was an industrious, faithful and esteemed resident. He is survived by his widow [Isabelle], three sons, Charles of Brooklyn, Frank of Syracuse and by two daughters, Mrs. Seward [Jennie] Walrath and Miss Alvina of this village. The funeral will be held from his late home Monday afternoon at 2 o'clock, the Rev. E. [Edward] A. Perry [Universalist] of Cooperstown officiating.
