Mrs. Calvin Brockett passed away at her home in this place Wednesday afternoon at two o'clock after a protracted illness. A prayer was held at the house by Rev. R. B. Fishbeck at 9:30 a.m., after which the body was taken to Dolgeville, her former home, for burial. The funeral was held at the home of her daughter, Mrs. William Earhart, at 2:00 p.m. Sunday. The Rev. C. [Clinton] A. Moulton of the Universalist Church officiated. Burial was made in the Dolgeville cemetery.

Mrs. Brockett was born in Newhaven [New Haven], Oswego County, and was a daughter of Milton and Effie Walsworth Kibbe. Her maiden name was Ione Kibbe. She died on her 67th birthday. Most of her life was spent in Dolgeville until five years ago, when the family moved to East Hamilton where she has been a kind neighbor.

Besides her husband she leaves three daughters, Mrs. Frank Coso of Palatine Bridge, Mrs. William Earharat of Dolgeville [and] Mrs. Bertha Tompkins of Dolgeville, and a brother, Aramiah Kibbe, of Richfield Springs.
