Fort Plain—Mrs. Florence Brookman, 77, of RD 3, a charter member of Otsquago Grange, and active in national, state and Pomona Grange circles, died suddenly yesterday while visiting her daughter, Mrs. Ralph Pollock, 53 Knollwood Ave., Amsterdam. Natural causes was given as cause of death by the attending physician.
