MRS. ANNIE BROWN

The death of Mrs. Anne Brown of Victor occurred on December 3 in her home at Victor. Mrs. Brown was approaching her ninety-first birthday and was the oldest member of the Universalist church in Macedon. She was a loyal member of this church and always attended the meetings of the Ontario Association of Universalists. As a young girl she was greatly interested in the work of this church at Macedon. In her eighteenth year she was married to George Boughton, Jr., the son of the Rev. George Boughton¹ who was the first minister of this church. They moved to Victor and affiliated with the Universalist church in this village until it was discontinued. Friends will recall her tragic experience in meeting with the death [in 1929] of her husband and son [Wellington] within a day of each other. In her seventy-fifth year she was married to Fred C. Brown whose death occurred in 1940. The Rev. John O. Bennett conducted the memorial service and the burial was in the cemetery at Macedon.
