MRS. CELIA E. BROWN EXPIRES AT RIVER BANK

Carthage, Oct. 21.—Mrs. Celia E. Brown, aged 52 years, one month and 26 days, wife of Fred J. Brown, died yesterday at her home at Riverbank. The funeral will be held Monday afternoon at 2 from the home, Rev. G. D. [George Delbert] Walker [Universalist] officiating. Burial will be made at Fairview cemetery. She had been in poor health for some time, her condition being serious for the past ten days.

Mrs. Brown was born at Edwards, Aug. 25, 1870, daughter of the late David and Jurane Noble. She was married March 25, 1891 at Canton but had lived in Carthage and vicinity since 1901.

Surviving are her husband; three daughters, Mrs. Charles Radley, Miss Florence Brown and Miss Gertrude Brown of Carthage; one son, James Brown of Carthage; one sister, Mrs. F. L. Brown of the state of Washington; one brother, Dr. U. [Urbane] A.
