C. M. Brown, 89, Dies; Little Falls Resident

LITTLE FALLS—Charles M. Brown, 89, of 50 Arthur St., an employe[e] of Little Falls Felt Shoe Co. for 50 years and superintendent for many years, died Friday in Little Falls Hospital after a long illness.

Bom Feb. 21, 1875 in Middleville, the son of William and Jennie Fenner Brown, he married Gertrude Gerhardt March 31, 1906 in Dolgeville. She died in 1948. Mr. Brown joined the Felt Shoe firm in 1909, retiring in 1959. He was a member of the Masons, Elks, and Maennerchor for over 50 years.

Surviving are a daughter, Miss Gertrude Brown, Little Falls; two grandchildren, and two great-grandchildren.

Rev. Robert Sterling, St. Paul's Universalist Church pastor, conducted services at 2 p.m. today from the Shepardson Funeral Home, with Rev. Robert Truman Menadue, former pastor, assisting. Burial was in Middleville Cemetery.
