

[Brown, Diana Marsh]

Mrs. Diana Brown, widow of the late Otis Brown, died Monday, Sept. 4th at her home near Mannsville, aged 96 years. Mrs. Brown was born in Herkimer county, but had resided most of her life in the town of Ellisburg. Her maiden name was Marsh, and her father was a soldier in the revolutionary war. She was the mother of three children, two of whom survive her, W. Corydon Brown of Mannsville, and Mrs. Edwin A. Allen, with whom Mrs. Brown lived and where she received the kindest attention for the last few years in her helpless condition. Mrs. Brown was probably the oldest person in the Ellisburg, and a woman of wonderful vitality. Up to three years ago, when she received an injury, she had excellent health. She enjoyed mental as well as bodily health and strength and her personal attributes were such that she had the respect and esteem of all who knew her. Mrs. Brown was a lifelong Universalist. The funeral was held on the Wednesday following, Rev. Luther Rice of Watertown officiating.
