

[Brown, Eliza La Fontaine]

Hubbardsville, March 31—Mrs. Eliza Brown, 87, died Monday at the home of her son, George Kalfics, after an illness of seventeen weeks. Mrs. Brown was born in Baldwinsville, N.Y. September 7, 1843 and was one of the twelve children of George and Genevive La Fontaine, and was the last of her family to survive. In 1860 she was united in marriage to John Kalfics, who died in 1867. Her marriage to William Brown occurred May 8, 1869 at Sherburne, N.Y. Mr. Brown died August 14, 1896. Mrs. Brown had lived in this locality practically all her life and was a member of the Universalist church. Surviving is one son, George Kalfics, with whom she lived, three grandchildren and six great-grandchildren. The funeral was held from the home of her son on Wednesday afternoon and burial was made in the Hubbardsville cemetery.
