James G. Brown, 79, well known resident here, retired farmer and former town and village official, died at his home at 11 West Park Street late Wednesday. He was a member and for several years he was a trustee of the Pullman Memorial Universalist Church, also a member of Renovation Lodge No. 97 F. & A.M. and of Orleans Chapter. He was supervisor and assessor one term of the town of Albion and he served one term as trustee of the village. In politics he was a lifelong Republican.
