Miss Mary W. Brown

Miss Mary W. Brown, one of Utica's oldest residents died at her home, 421 Whitesboro street, at 7 o'clock this morning. She fell about 18 weeks ago and injured her spine and owing to her old age she was unable to recover. Miss Brown was born in Scotland January 23, 1823, and came to this country with her parents when eight years of age. She lived in Utica over 60 years, and for the past thirty years occupied the house in which she died. Miss Brown was one of the first dressmakers to do work in this city. She was a member of the Church of the Reconciliation [Universalist]. She is survived by two sisters, Mrs. W. E. Jones of Utica and Miss Catharine McLean of Brookfield, Mo.
