Hubbardsville, March 17.—Frank H. Brownell, native of this place, died Sunday, March 8th, at his home in Utica, where he was spending the winter, after an illness of more than six months. Mr. Brownell was born here March 10, 1856, and was the son of the late Nathan and Rosalia Hart Brownell. He received his education here, and for many years was in the hop growing business with his father. About 30 years of his life was spent in New York City, where he was active in politics. In 1914 he came back to Hubbardsville to live. For the last five years he spent the winters in Utica. Mr. Brownell married Alzada Wilson, 53 years ago. He was a member of the Universalist Church. Surviving are his widow and a daughter, Mrs. O. Edward Merrill, of Syracuse; a sister, Mrs. Harry Morgan, Madison, and three grandchildren. His funeral was held last Tuesday afternoon from his home in Utica.
