MRS. ELIZABETH BRYANT

The death of Mrs. Elizabeth Vanderhoof, wife of the late Dr. N. S. Bryant, occurred at the home of her daughter, Mrs. W. H. Carr, in Gypsum, Tuesday. Mrs. Bryant was born on April 7, 1817, in the vicinity in which she died and in which she has spent almost her entire life. She was married to Dr. Bryant in 1846, who died about 10 years ago. Mrs. Bryant was the oldest daughter of the late Jacob Vanderhoof and, of the large family of children only one child, Mrs. Lucy Mosher, now survives. Mrs. Bryant was in very good health up to within the past four weeks when she was taken with the grip. She is survived by three children, William Bryant, Jacob V. Bryant and Mrs. Helen M. Carr. The funeral will be held this afternoon, Rev. J. J. Brayton [Universalist] officiating.
