MRS. MARY BUCK OF RANDALL DIES

RANDALL, Jan. 25—Mrs. Mary E. Buck, 70, widow of Frank W. Buck, died yesterday at 2:20 p.m. in Herkimer Memorial Hospital.

She had been in failing health for several months and had been making her home with her daughter, Mrs. William Lusso, Randall. Mrs. Buck suffered a stroke while eating lunch and died shortly after being admitted to the hospital.

Born in Salisbury, October 13, 1881, she was a daughter of Levi and Elizabeth Flanders House. She was a resident of Salisbury virtually all her life. For four years Mrs. Buck was associated with the Herkimer County Sheriff's Office.

Mrs. Buck was a member of the Universalist Church of Salisbury Center and the church Ladies Aid Society.

Nieces and nephews, in addition to her daughter, survive.

The body was taken to the Todd funeral home, Fultonville, where it will remain until Sunday. The body will then lie in state at the Salisbury Center Universalist Church from 1 to 2 p.m. Sunday.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 o'clock Sunday by the Rev. Clinton Moulton, retired pastor of the Dolgeville Universalist Church.

Spring burial will be in the Salisbury Corners Cemetery.
