OBITUARY

Mrs. Margaret E. Buckland, wife of Walter H. Buckland, died at her home two miles west of Perry Center, Friday August 22nd, of typhoid fever, aged 28 years. Deceased was the youngest daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Goodale [and Charlotte Macomber] Bacon of West Perry, and when she grew to womanhood she was married January 1st, 1896, to Mr. Walter H. Buckland. The large concourse of sympathetic friends who attended the funeral Monday afternoon was evidence of the love and sympathy of all who knew her. The beautiful floral tributes to her memory were but another evidence of how many hearts had loved her. The services were conducted by Rev. Charles Palmatier [Universalist], who paid a tender and fitting tribute to the memory of the departed. She is survived by a stricken husband and two children [Noble B. and George R., known as G. Ralph], the youngest only two weeks old [G. Ralph, born 8 Aug 1902.] The interment was in beautiful Hope cemetery.
