DIED.

In Frankfort, N.Y., on the 3d of November, CALEB BUDLONG, M.D., aged 74 years. Dr. Budlong had long been a resident and practicing physician of the village, and his practice extended often through Herkimer and to other adjacent counties. The infirmities of age and an accident that befell him a few years since rendered him incapable of practicing his profession some time previous to his death. In faith he had long been a Universalist, and continued to cherish this all sustaining faith to the last. He had formed a wide circle of friends and acquaintances. He was a member of the Masonic Fraternity, and by request, was buried in due Masonic order. The funeral was attended on Sunday, November 5th, a brief discourse being delivered by Rev. D. [Dolphus] Skinner, and the Masonic services being conducted by Mr. Sheldon, Master of the Frankfort Lodge, assisted by the brethren. He leaves a widow [Susan Murray Budlong], one son and one daughter [Jane Elizabeth, wife of Chauncey Ellwood] to mourn his loss. But they mourn not like those without hope.
