CLARK L. BULLION

Richfield Springs—Clark L. Bullion, 81, died Dec. 3, 1946 at his home in Church St., after a long illness.

He was born in Warren, N.Y., son of James and Phoebe Cole Bullion. He was educated in the old Goodyear Seminary in Richfield Springs. In 1884 he married Ida M. Bellinger, who died in December, 1933. On Dec. 4, (1936?) he married Mrs. Pearl A. Zoller of Utica. His only son, Harry, died in 1911.

Mr. Bullion formerly conducted a farm in Cullen, N.Y., retiring in 1921. For about 15 years he had spent most of the winters in California and Texas. He was a member of the old Universalist Church.

Mr. Bullion was at one time a director of the First National Bank of Richfield Springs. At the time of his death he was president of the Cemetery Commission. His wife survives. There are no other near relatives.

The funeral will be held at 2 p.m. Friday from the home, the Rev. C. Frederick Fraser, pastor of the Presbyterian Church, and the Rev. Mr. Moulton of Dolgeville, officiating. Burial will be in Lakeview Cemetery.
