DIED, In Perrinton [old spelling for Perinton], Jan. 19, Mr. Asa Bullock, aged 72. Father Bullock had been a believer in the doctrine of Universalism from his youth, and we learn had always practically exemplified his faith through life. He was one of the earliest supporters of the doctrine where he lived, and was a member of the Universalist Church in Fairport. It was Universalism that sustained him in the decline of life, and no subject seemed to engage his attention like this... The good old patriarch has gone to rest, and we pray that the religion which supported his soul may comfort his surviving companion and children, and fit them for life, and death, and heaven.
