Funeral of Cortland Man Will Be Held Tomorrow

Cortland, Nov. 22—Funeral services for William M. Burch, who died suddenly Tuesday night at his home, 113 Clinton avenue, will be held tomorrow afternoon at 2:30 o'clock at the house. The Rev. J. [Joseph] A. Judge, pastor of the Universalist church, will officiate. Burial will be in Cortland rural cemetery.

He was born in Westbury Feb. 3, 1859, and married Miss Lottie Sherman at Summerhill Feb. 17, 1878. He came to this city 25 years ago and had made his home here ever since. He was an employe[e] of the Brewer-Titchener Corporation.

Besides his wife he is survived by a son, Howard Burch, of this city, and a daughter, Mrs. Alta Weaver of Cortlandville; a sister, Mary Brandon of Los Angeles, Calif.; a half-sister, Susie White of Spokane, Wash.; and two half-brothers, Colvin Burch of Manchester, Ia., and Eugene Burch of Fort Dodge, Ia.
