Mrs. Burdick, 91, Lyons Falls, Dies

LYONS FALLS—Mrs. Jennie Petrie Burdick, 91, widow of Clarence Burdick, died Friday in the Jordan Nursing Home where she had been confined for five weeks.

The daughter of Soloman and Helen Getman Petrie, she was born July 29, 1864 in Little Falls, and was married to Mr. Burdick there on March 29, 1882. He died May 3, 1927.

A dressmaker, Mrs. Burdick had resided at Burdick's Crossing for 73 years.

Her ancestors were early settlers in the Mohawk Valley, coming from Alsace-Lorraine. A coat of arms of the Petrie family is incorporated into one of the stained glass windows in the Universalist Church, Little Falls. Mrs. Burdick was a member of that church.

She is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Edgar (Orpha) Linedecker, Lyons Falls, and Mrs. Lester (Ethel) Rudd Sr., Burdick's Crossing; a son, Raymond Burdick, Lee Center; a brother, Elmer A. Petrie, Little Falls; 11 grandchildren, 19 great-grandchildren and seven great-great-grandchildren; also several nieces and nephews.
