Miss Burnett of Webster Dies at 92

Miss Ida Burnett, member of a pioneer Webster family and for several years manager of the family fruit farm at the corner of Lake Rd. and Burnett Rd., died yesterday (July 5, 1953) at the age of 92.

Miss Burnett was born in Webster May 6, 1861, the daughter of Giles and Mary Jane Foster Burnett. Her grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Abraham Foster, were among the first settlers in Webster.

Miss Burnett attended public schools in Rochester and was a graduate of Mechanics Institute, now Rochester Institute of Technology, where she studied art. She lived in the family homestead in Webster until three years ago when she moved into the village of Webster.

Miss Burnett had been bedridden for the past two months because of a broken hip. She was a member of the Universalist Church of Rochester and a life member of Webster Grange.

Surviving are several nieces and nephews.

Funeral services will be held at 2:30 p.m. tomorrow in the Ward L. Tinklepaugh Funeral Home, Webster. Burial will be in Webster Rural Cemetery.
