James Burnett Dead

James Edward Burnett, aged 67 years died at his home here Saturday, May 7, 1927 after a long and tedious illness of shock and injuries sustained in a fall about three years ago. Mr. Burnett, who was born in Frankford, Canada, had spent nearly forty years in this village where until incapacitated he had employment on the railroad as section foreman. He married Mary E. Rodgers in Rawdon, Canada in 1883 and besides his widow is survived by one son John A., of Wellsburg, N. Y., one daughter, Mrs. J. B. Truax of West Bingham, Pa., and eight grand children. The funeral, directed by Lodge 924, I. O. O. F., was held yesterday, May 11, 1927 from the home at 1 o'clock and burial in Rural Cemetery, Rev R. S. Kellerman of the Univeralist Church officiating.
