Death of Henry Burns

After an illness of two years, Henry Burns, a life long resident of Natural Bridge, died at Willard last Friday. He was born in Natural Bridge 72 years ago, the son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Thomas Burns. During the Civil war he served with the Union forces. Soon after his return from the war he married Miss Mahala Williamson, of Natural Bridge, who survives. Mr. Burns was a Democrat, and served as county Committeeman for years from his district. During the Sulzer-Glynn Administrations Mr. Burns held a State position in Albany. Surviving besides his widow are a son and a daughter, Mrs. Katherine Moorehouse of Boonville and Henry Burns of Marcellus. Two brothers and a sister also survive, James Burns, Mrs. Bemis of Natural Bridge, and a brother in the west. The funeral was held from his late home on Sunday at 2 o'clock, Rev. G. D. [George Delbert] Walker [Universalist], of Carthage, officiating.
