Mrs. Burns Dies at 87

Mrs. Lora Shoemaker Burns, 87, a former resident of Fort Plain, died early this morning at the Canajoharie Nursing Home, where she had been a patient for 6 months. She was the widow of Joseph Burns.

Born March 10, 1883 in Mohawk, she was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Alfred Shoemaker. She was a member of the Universalist Church of the Messiah in Fort Plain.

She was married to Mr. Burns in 1906. He died July 2, 1965.
