Mrs. Burroughs, Church Worker
Woman's League Head At All Souls Was 86

Mrs. Agnes Zelmira Burroughs, a lifelong resident of Brooklyn and an active member of the All Souls Universalist Church of Flatbush for 64 years, died yesterday at her home, 2105 Foster Ave. She was 86.

A native of Brooklyn, Mrs. Burroughs devoted a great part of her life to church work and for many years was the head of the Women's League of All Souls Church, as well as chairman of the Central Circle. Thirty-one years ago she was co-chairman of the Dutch Fair, which was sponsored by the church.

Mrs. Burroughs is survived by a daughter, Mrs. Elsey King Metcalfe. Funeral services will be held at 8 p.m. tomorrow in the Fairchild Chapel, 86 Lefferts Place, with the Rev. Cornelius Greenway, pastor of All Souls Church, officiating. Burial will be private.
