DEATHS.

At Frankfort, on the 22d of February last, Andrew Jackson, the only surviving son of Mr. Asel Burt, aged 4 years. He was born on the 8th of January, 1828, the day on which Gen. Jackson's victory was celebrated throughout the United States; and died on the centennial anniversary of Washington's birth. His death was occasioned by a tumor commencing in his right side, which continued to enlarge until it filled the whole abdominal [sic] region, and was found on *post mortem* examination, to weight three and one half pounds. Of four lovely children only one now survives.
