MRS. FRANK F. BURTCH

FONDA, March 11.—Cora Letitia Phillips, widow of Frank Fuller Burtch, died suddenly last night at her home in New York City, of a heart attack. She had been a resident of Fonda for many years, and always spent her Summers here. She was born August 19, 1861, at South Hammond, N.Y., the only child of William Wallace Phillips and Nancy Moyer. She was a member of the Universalist Church at Fort Plain, and for a number of years was organist there. [On] August 25, 1880, she was married to Mr. Burtch, who died September 15, 1907.

Mrs. Burtch is survived by one son, Attorney A. Howard Burtch, Fonda; one daughter, Miss Charlotte Burtch, New York City [who had lived with her]; three grandchildren and one great-granddaughter.

The body will arrive in Fonda this afternoon, accompanied by Miss Burtch, and will be taken to the home of Attorney Burtch on Montgomery Terrace, where the funeral will be held Tuesday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock. The Rev. Dr. Putnam Cady, pastor of the Fonda Reformed Church, will officiate. Interment will be in the family plot in Caughnawaga Cemetery.
