Death of Miss Eliza J. Butler

At ten minutes past nine o'clock yesterday morning, Miss ELIZA J. BUTLER breathed her last at the residence of S. Curt Lewis, corner of Walnut and Cottage streets, in this city, in the 67th year of her age. Miss Butler has been ailing for some time past, with heart disease, which was the direct cause of her death. Miss Butler has been boarding recently with Mr. and Mrs. Warren Chrysler, on Washburn street, but on Tuesday of last week she went to the residence of her niece, Mrs. S. Curt Lewis, to see her sister, Mrs. John Jenny, of Elmore, Ohio, who arrived the night previous on a visit. Here she was taken sick and died as stated above.

While Miss Butler's death was not entirely unexpected, the news of it will cast a sorrow over the hearts of a host of relatives and friends in this city who have known her intimately for years. The deceased was a member of the Universalist church and a sincere Christian lady. The funeral services will be held at the residence of Mr. S. Curt Lewis at 3 o'clock to-morrow afternoon.
