—The remains of Mrs. Elizabeth Phillips Butler, widow of Simeon Butler, were brought here from Rome for burial Tuesday. She died at the home of her brother, Nelson Phillips, with whom she had made her home the past two years. She was born in this town 87 years ago last September and had spent all her life in this section excepting the past two years. She was one of the best known residents of the town and also one of the oldest. Last June she fell and since that time has been confined to the bed, death coming from a general wear out of the system. Rev. O. [Otis] F. Alvord of the Universalist Church of Rome conducted the funeral services at the church here and Mrs. Angell sang several selections.
