Geneva—Mrs. Ida J. Butler, wife of the Rev. B. [Benjamin] F. Butler¹, pastor in the Seneca Castle Village Presbyterian Church near Geneva, died Thursday (June 15, 1944) in Thompson Memorial Hospital in Canandaigua after a brief illness.

Mrs. Butler was the daughter of Lieut. and Mrs. Charles C. Eddy of Theresa in Northern New York where she was educated.

Besides her husband, Mrs. Butler is survived by a daughter, Mrs. Mark [Lois] Estey of Clifton Springs; a brother, George E. Eddy of Theresa; two granddaughters, Barbara and Constance Estey and several nephews and nieces.

The Rev. Nelson L. Lobdell [Universalist] of Victor will conduct the funeral services in the Butler home in Seneca Castle at 2 p.m. tomorrow. Burial will be in Orleans Cemetery.
