MRS. MINNIE BUTLER

Little Falls—Mrs. Minnie Pickard Butler died Monday night, July 24, 1939, at the home of her sister, Miss Elva Pickard, [390?] W. Main, after an illness of three years.

She was born at Orleans Four Corners, Jefferson County, daughter of Robert and Mary Coville Pickard. She attended the Universalist Church and was graduated from the Clinton Liberal Institute, Fort Plain. She was a music teacher and church organist and engaged in other musical activities.

Mrs. Pickard was descended from Martin Dettinger and Elisha Campion, who came to this country from England in 1823. Mrs. Pickard lived in Utica for 10 years and in Little Falls for the last 12 years. The sister is the only survivor.

Funeral services will be conducted at the sister's home at 1:30 Thursday afternoon, the Rev. Howard Gilman officiating. Burial will be in Fairview Cemetery.
