Mrs. Nellie Calvert Dies; Rites Sunday at Colvin St. Home

Mrs. Nellie Moore Calvert, widow of LaMont Calvert, of 132 East Colvin Street, died Wednesday. She was a member of the Auxiliary of the Railway Mail Clerks' Association, of the Ladies' Historical Club and of Betts Memorial [Universalist] Church. Mrs. Moore was graduated from Watertown High School in 1878 and from Cortland Normal School in 1882. She taught for two years at Dryden High School before her marriage.
