Mrs. Frances Edwina Carey

Frances Edwina, widow of the late I. [Ira] C. Carey, died very suddenly at about 7 o'clock Tuesday morning, March 1st, as she was arising from her bed for the day. Esther Colburn, who was staying with her, immediately sent word to a son, N. W. Carey, but Mrs. Carey passed away before he arrived.

Mrs. Carey was born in Dutchess county, March 24th, 1840, which would make her eighty-two years old the present month. The cause of her death was old age and heart trouble. Her parents were William and Mary (Fowler) Williams. She was married to I. C. Carey in 1861 and came to Otsego county to live. They resided at Westford, Cooperstown and Laurens, coming to Morris about forty-seven years ago where Mr. Carey conducted a market most of the time until he died a few years ago. In her younger years she was a teacher in Westford.

She is survived by one son, N. [Norman] W. Carey, who has looked after her welfare since the death of her husband, and also relatives in Milford and Oneonta. Mrs. Carey was a woman well known and respected by many friends. The funeral was held Thursday afternoon from her late home, the Rev. F. [Frederick] G. Leonard of the Universalist church officiating and the remains were placed in the receiving vault in Hillington cemetery.
