Mrs. Carlson, Former Piano Teacher, Dies

Mrs. Martinette Drayton Carlson, 70, of Bemus Point, died in W. C. A. Hospital at 6:30 A.M. today (Aug. 19, 1960).

For many years Mrs. Carlson gave piano lessons in Bemus Point. She was a member of the Mozart Club in Jamestown.

Mrs. Carlson was born in Corry, Pa., March 12, 1890 to LaVern and Pauline Phillips Dunham. Her husband, John Carlson, died several years ago. She had lived in this area most of her life.
