FORMER AREA TEACHER DIES

Edmeston—Mrs. Cora Carnwright, 90, died yesterday at the Sara Ward Home, Edmeston, after an illness of two and a half months.

She was born Sept. 30, 1868, in the Town Armenia, Bradford County, Pa., the daughter of Walter and Nancy Ripley Bullard.

She attended Bradford County schools and the Mansfield Normal School in Mansfield, Pa. She taught in the Oneida area for several years.

On April 12, 1891, she was married to Charles¹ Carnwright. He died Feb. 8, 1948.

Mrs. Carnwright was a member of the Universalist Church of Troy, Pa., where her father had been pastor for several years.

She leaves one son, Lloyd, of Canton, Pa.; two daughters, Mrs. Gladys Bristol, Tacoma Park, Md., and Mrs. Geneieve [sic] Harrington, Edmeston; 10 grandchildren and 25 great grandchildren. Another daughter, Mrs. Jessie Weaver, died several years ago.

The funeral will be at 2 tomorrow from the Houk-Johnston Funeral Home, with the Rev. Leonard N. Davis, pastor emeritus of the Methodist Church, officiating. Burial will be in Edmeston Union Cemetery.
