Watertown, May 19.—George W. Carpenter, proprietor of the Center house at Adams Center, died at 5 o'clock this morning from cancer of the liver and stomach. The deceased was born in Watertown 58 years ago, and lived here 30 years. Then he went to Gouverneur, where he conducted a tannery, afterward engaging in the hotel business. Among the hotels he conducted are: Franklin House, Rathbun at Cape Vincent and Gibeau House at Mannsville. He was a member of Gouverneur lodge, F. & A.M. and for two years was deputy grand master of the St. Lawrence masonic district. He was a strong republican and a Universalist. He married Miss Clarinda Becker of Summerville, and they had four children, only one of whom survives, George, jr. John Carpenter of this city is his brother, and Mrs. W. W. Richey of Denver, Col., and Mrs. P. E. Lamon of this city are his sisters.
