Frank W. Carter

Frank W. Carter, 81, died at his home, No. 9 Raymond avenue, at 4:15 o'clock this morning following a heart attack. Mr. Carter, the last of a family of seven children of the late William and Hannah Finch Carter, was born in the town of Darien on October 26, 1855. For four years Mr. Carter served as postmaster at the Sawens post office in the town of Darien, where he was engaged in farming for many years prior to moving to Batavia in February, 1917. Surviving Mr. Carter are his wife, Belle Rogers Carter, and three nieces, including Mrs. George Muxworthy of Darien.

Funeral services for Mr. Carter will be held at his late home at 2 o'clock Saturday afternoon, the Rev. Harry Wright, pastor of the Universalist Church of Bristol, officiating. Interment will be at Corfu.
