Herbert H. Carver, aged 80 years, died Thursday morning at 11 o'clock after a long illness of a complication of diseases. He was born in Syracuse, the son of John and Rachel [Shepard] Carver. Mr. Carver came to Fort Plain when a lad of 16 years of age and had resided here for most of the time since. For a number of years he was engaged in the harness business and at one time was a member of the Old Fort Plain band. Besides his wife [Anna Selwood Carver] he is survived by three sisters, Mrs. A. A. Young of Newark, N.Y., Mrs. Elnora Diefendorf of Syracuse and Mrs. Linda Bergen of Cicero; two daughters, Mr. J. R. Hagaman of Palmyra and Mrs. Wells Taylor of Albany; one son, Fred S. Carver of this village, and several grandchildren. The funeral was held Sunday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock at the Catharine Nellis Memorial chapel, the Rev. Herbert F. Moulton [Universalist] officiating. The body was placed in the Catharine Nellis Memorial vault, and burial will be made in the spring in the Fort Plain cemetery.
