Ralph W. Case Rites Are Held

Bristol—Friends from here attended the funeral Thursday of Ralph W. Case, 79, of [at] the Brown funeral home in Honeoye. He died Jan. 2 at the Lukenback nursing home, So. Livonia, after [a] long period of failing health.

Born in this town March 12, 1876, he was a son of Ogden and Harriet Donnelson Case, and had spent his life in this and the Allens Hill area. He was a farmer as long as health permitted. On Jan. 20, 1897, he was married to Georgia Lambert of Allens Hill, who died in April, 1950. They observed their golden wedding anniversary in 1947.

He leaves two sons, Leslie Case of Bristol, with whom he resided, and Carroll Case of East Randolph. Their oldest son Ellis died in early manhood. A sister, Mrs. Nellie Hanna of Rochester, also survives.

Rev. Harry M. Wright [Universalist], pastor emeritus of Bristol Center, and Rev. William Brown, retired pastor of Livonia, conducted the service and interment was at the Allens Hill cemetery [in Richmond].
