Betsy Parmela Casler, widow of George H. Casler passed away at 5:15 o'clock yesterday afternoon at the home of her daughter, Mrs. George W. Van Alstyne, 322 North Washington street, after several weeks' illness of heart trouble. She was born [83?] years ago in the town of Warren and her maiden name was Betsy Parmela Maxfield. Sixty years ago she was united in marriage to George Casler, who died several years ago. Mrs. Casler had resided with her daughter since 1900, having previously made her residence in Warren. She was a member of the Universalist Church and of the Ladies' Aid Society and took an active part so long as health permitted. Surviving are two sons, Myron H. Casler, superintendent of the County Home; Charles Casler of Jordanville, and the daughter, Mrs. Van Alstyne, and a brother, Isaac Maxfield of Jordanville; also several grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.
