WAS SECRETARY OF MASONIC LODGE 34 YRS. Late Amos Castle of Middleport Served in Civil War and was 84 Years Old

MIDDLEPORT, Sept, 21.—Amos A. Castle, aged 84 years, died Sunday evening at the home in Vernon Street. He is survived by his wife [Anna], a daughter, Mr. S. Evinger at home, a son Harry Castle of Rochester, two brothers, Burt of Gasport [and] Frank of Michigan and a sister, Mrs. George Coon of Yates.

Mr. Castle was a Civil War veteran having served three years in the war and was a member of the G.A.R. until a year ago when it disbanded. The funeral will be held Wednesday afternoon at three o'clock from the home and three-thirty o'clock from the First Universalist Church of which the deceased was a member. The Rev. I. V. Lobdell will officiate. Burial will take place in Hartland Central Cemetery. The service will be under the auspices of the Masonic fraternity.
