CASWELL—In the town of Exeter, April 1st, 1898, John Richmond Caswell

The deceased was born in Connecticut in 1820, and at the time of his death had completed his 78th year. In early life he removed to this state, and had lived since 1863 upon the farm where he closed his days. Mr. Caswell was a man of great energy of character, of industrious habits, and a recognized force in the community where he passed so many active years. He was a good neighbor, and a provident husband and father. In June 1845 he was united in marriage with Miss Lucy Herkimer of Schuyler Lake, who survives him, together with one brother, an aged sister, three sons: Dwight, residing in the state of Washington; Thomas, superintendent of public schools in the city of Little Falls, and Schuyler, whose home has always been with his parents, and one grandson, Frank Schuyler, son of Dwight. The funeral services were held on the 4th inst., at the family residence, Rev. S. [Samuel] R. Ward [Universalist] officiating.
