Death of Mrs. Adelia Chaddock

Mrs. Adelia Chaddock, widow of the late Suel Chaddock, passed away about two o'clock on Monday morning at her home on Clay street, after failing in health for some months. For the past few weeks she had been confined to her bed.

Mrs. Chaddock was born in Covington 82 years ago, her maiden name being Adelia Shumway. Most of her life had, however, been passed in LeRoy. On October 8, 1850, she was married to A. T. Price, whose death occurred on Augusts 29, 1867 and on October 18, 1886, she was united in marriage to Suel Chaddock, who died on November 29, 1897.

Mrs. Chaddock was much interested in church work, being a member of the Universalist church. She was a woman highly esteemed in the community. For some time she had suffered from the infirmities of age and had expressed a desire to depart this life.

The deceased is survived by one son, Louis L. Price, of Troy, also a stepson, Frank E. Chaddock. She is also survived by two sisters, Mrs. W. H. Tillou, of Le Roy, and Mrs. Elijah Tillotson, of Pavilion; also one brother, Alonzo Shumway, of Power City, S. D.

The funeral was held this afternoon at two o'clock from the house, Rev. Clara Morgan, of Perry, officiating and the interment was made in Machpelah cemetery.
