MISS MINNIE CHAFFEE  
Former Resident of Cortland Dies In Syracuse

Miss Minnie Chaffee, 80, former resident of Cortland, died yesterday in Syracuse following a long illness. Miss Chaffee was the only child of Elmer D. and Ellen Perrigo Chaffee and was born in Dryden July 6, 1874.

The family moved to the Chaffee farm near Gracie in 1878. After the death of her father in 1910, Miss Chaffee resided in Cortland with her mother and was well known as a dressmaker. Mrs. Chaffee died in March 1912 and Miss Chaffee went to Syracuse to live the following March. She was an active member of the Universalist church of Syracuse and the Mary Browning Betts Circle of the King's Daughters, also of Syracuse. No near relatives survive.

The funeral services will be held at 11 Thursday morning at the late home, (118?) Concord Place, Syracuse. Rev. E. [Ellsworth] C. Reamon, pastor of the Universalist Church of Syracuse, will officiate. Burial will be made in the family plot in Cortland.
